3 Years in State Prison for Assault with Box Cutter



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that LEROY STANFORD, 26, of Albany, was sentenced 3 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On July 29, 2013, STANFORD pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony

On April 13, 2013 on First Street in the City of Albany, the defendant was at a party when he began arguing with an individual who is known to him. STANFORD eventually threatened the victim with physical violence.

When the victim left the party in an attempt to flee the defendant, STANFORD followed her and sliced the victim with a box cutter on the hand and also on her ear. This assault caused physical injury and required a total of 25 stitches.

Assistant District Attorney Carmen Warner of the Street Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
