8 Years in State Prison for Violent Stabbing



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ELIAS DELIGIANNIS, 33, of Guilderland, was sentenced to a determinate State Prison sentence of 8 years and 5 years of Post Release Supervision before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On May 2, 2013, DELIGIANNIS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the First Degree, a Class C Violent Felony.

On March 30, 2013 at approximately 12:08am at a residence in the Town of Colonie, DELIGIANNIS did stab a male victim repeatedly in the head, torso, and appendages after the parties were engaged in an argument. The victim suffered a punctured lung and multiple stab wounds that required surgery.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hauf of the Major Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
