Albany Man Sentenced for Possession of Counterfeit Twenty Dollar Bills



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **JEFFREY TIMMONS**, 46, of Albany, was sentenced to 2 years in the Albany County Correctional Facility before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On September 26, 2013, TIMMONS pleaded guilty to (2) Counts of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument in the First Degree, both Class D Felonies.

On September 5, 2013 in the City of Albany, the defendant did unlawfully possess four counterfeit twenty dollar bills and did use them at multiple stores to purchase pizza and liquor.

Assistant District Attorney Benjamin Clark of the Financial Crimes Unit oversaw the prosecution of this case.
