## Defendant Pleads Guilty to Attempting to Steal Televisions from Restaurant



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JUNIOR JENNINGS, 18, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On March 1, 2014, the defendant broke into DeJohns Restaurant and Pub on Lark Street in the City of Albany by breaking through a window in the back of the building. Once inside, the defendant used a power drill to attempt to steal multiple televisions.

Officers from the Albany Police Department responded to the scene and found the defendant inside the building. After a brief foot chase, the defendant was apprehended.

JENNINGS faces 2 ½ to 5 years in State Prison when sentenced on May 15, 2014.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Legal Affairs Bureau is handling the prosecution of this case.
