Defendant Sentenced to 6 Years in State Prison for Selling Cocaine



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JAMES DOMINIC, 32, of Colonie, was sentenced to 6 ½ years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On January 8, 2014, DOMINIC pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class C Felony.

On August 6, 2013 on Knapp Terrace in the Town of Colonie, the defendant was observed selling cocaine by members of the Colonie Police Department.

This case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Kurt Haas of the Street Crimes Unit.
