## Drunk Driver Who Registered .23% BAC Pleads Guilty



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DOMONICK FISH, 61, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated, a Class E Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On September 29, 2013 on Central Avenue in the Town of Colonie, the defendant drove his vehicle through the parking lot of Shop Rite and made a left turn, hitting another vehicle in the parking lot. When officers arrived, the defendant exhibited several physical signs of intoxication, failed multiple field sobriety tests and registered a BAC of .23% while in police custody.

FISH faces 1 to 3 years in State Prison, the installation of an Ignition Interlock Device for 3 years following his release, a \$1,000 fine and license revocation when sentenced on February 12, 2014.

The trial in the matter of the People of the State of New York v. Domonick Fish was scheduled to begin on December 16, 2013, at which point the defendant would have faced a maximum of 1 1/3 to 4 years in State Prison if convicted.

Vehicular Crimes Bureau Chief Mary Tanner-Richter is handling the prosecution of this case.
