## Former Bank Teller Pleads Guilty to Stealing \$80,000 and Tax Fraud



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **JEFFREY ROSCOE**, of Crown Point, New York, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Grand Larceny in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, and (1) Count of Tax Fraud in the Fourth Degree, a Class E Felony, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in the Supreme Court of Albany County this morning.

Between May 1, 2011 and December 15, 2011, the defendant, while working as a bank teller at Trustco Bank on Whitehall Road in the City of Albany, did steal approximately \$80,000. The defendant falsified multiple business records in order to conceal the missing money.

In addition, the defendant evaded over \$3,000 in New York State income tax during 2011 by failing to file a personal income tax return as required by law.

ROSCOE faces 3 to 9 years in State Prison when sentenced on March 18, 2014. The defendant must also pay restitution in the amount of \$83,607.19 to Trustco Bank and \$5,699 to the New York State Department of Taxation and Finance.

Assistant District Attorney Benjamin Clark of the Financial Crimes Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
