## Fourth Co-Defendant Sentenced to 10 Years in State Prison for Role in Fatal Robbery



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **ANTWAN UPTEGROW**, 36, of Albany, was sentenced to 10 years in State Prison before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

The defendant previously pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Robbery in the First Degree, a Class B Violent Felony.

On September 13, 2012 in the area near Ontario Street in the City of Albany, UPTEGROW and co-defendants BERNARD WHITE, 24, UQUAN BEAN, 22, and SHAQUAN OLIVER, 23, all of Albany, attempted to rob Alex Duncan, then 35, in front of a neighborhood business. During the robbery attempt, Duncan was shot in the chest and later taken to Albany Medical Center where he was pronounced dead.

On January 21, 2014, BERNARD WHITE and UQUAN BEAN each pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Robbery in the First Degree, a Class B Violent Felony. Additionally, on January 28, 2014, SHAQUAN OLIVER pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Robbery in the First Degree, a Class B Violent Felony.

On March 4, 2014, BERNARD WHITE was sentenced 20 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision and UQAUN BEAN was sentenced to 14 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision.

On March 11, 2014, SHAQUAN OLIVER was sentenced to 15 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision. This will be served consecutive to an unrelated 13 year State Prison sentence stemming from his conviction of (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class C Violent Felony, for a total of 28 years in State Prison.

These cases were prosecuted by Street Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Francisco Calderon.
