## Guilty Plea for Possession of Counterfeit Twenty Dollar Bills



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JEFFREY TIMMONS, 46, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (2) Counts of Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument in the First Degree, both Class C Felonies, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On September 5, 2013 in the City of Albany, the defendant did unlawfully possess four counterfeit twenty dollar bills and did use them at multiple stores to purchase pizza and liquor.

TIMMONS faces 1 year in the Albany County Correctional Facility for each Count of Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument in the First Degree when sentenced on November 7, 2013. This will be served consecutive to each other, for a total of 2 years.

Assistant District Attorney Benjamin Clark of the Financial Crimes Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
