Raymond Halacy Pleads Guilty for Role in Colonie Burglary



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **RAYMOND HALACY**, 19, of Rensselaer, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in Third Degree, a Class E Felony, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On November 28, 2013 on Haswell Road in the Town of Colonie, **RAYMOND HALACY**, co-defendant **JOHN HALACY**, 24, of Rensselaer, and alleged co-defendant **ANDRE BEVERLY**,

18, of Colonie, unlawfully entered a residence and stole guitars, a television and various other electronic items while inside.

Following the burglary, RAYMOND HALACY and alleged co-defendant ANDRE BEVERLY were located and remanded into custody by members of the U.S. Marshal Service in Florida and waived extradition back to New York State.

RAYMOND HALACY faces 2 1/3 to 7 years in State Prison when sentenced on April 8, 2014. He remains in custody at the Albany County Correctional Facility without bail.

On March 6, 2014, JOHN HALACY pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court and faces 5 ½ years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on April 3, 2014. HALACY will remain remanded in the Albany County Correctional Facility without bail to await sentencing.

The case against ANDRE BEVERLY remains open and pending at this time.

Bureau Chief Eric Galarneau of the Major Offense Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
