## Raymond Halacy Sentenced to 2 1/3 to 7 Years in State Prison for Role in Colonie Burglary



**ALBANY, NY** - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **RAYMOND HALACY**, 19, of Rensselaer, was sentenced to 2 1/3 to 7 years in State Prison before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On March 11, 2014, **HALACY** pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in Third Degree, a Class E Felony.

On November 28, 2013 on Haswell Road in the Town of Colonie, RAYMOND HALACY, co-defendant JOHN HALACY, 24, of Rensselaer, unlawfully entered a residence and stole guitars, a television and various other electronic items while inside.

Following the burglary, RAYMOND HALACY was located and remanded into custody by members of the U.S. Marshal Service in Florida and waived extradition back to New York State.

On March 6, 2014, JOHN HALACY pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court and was sentenced to 5 ½ years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on April 3, 2014.

Both cases were prosecuted by Bureau Chief Eric Galarneau of the Major Offense Unit.
