Street Crimes Bureau News: Five Defendants Convicted for Narcotics Possession, Sale

ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that LUIS NAVARRO, 27, of Albany, HENRY ADAMS, 42, of Albany and ISIAH SAUNDERS, 34, of Albany, pleaded guilty this week in Albany County Court for un-related narcotics possession and sale charges.

District Attorney Soares also announced that LEROY CHISOLM, 32, of Albany and DAYSHON MILLER, 20, of Albany were sentenced for their roles in un-related narcotics sale charges.

HENRY ADAMS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court on April 10, 2013.

On August 1, 2012, ADAMS was observed by members of the Albany Police Department selling crack cocaine on Clinton Avenue in the City of Albany.

ADAMS faces 3 ½ years in State Prison followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on May 15, 2013.

LUIS NAVARRO pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court on April 8, 2013.

On October 18, October 25 and October 29, 2012, NAVARRO was observed by members of the Albany Police Department selling heroin in the area of Madison Avenue and Knox Street in the City of Albany. Pursuant to a search warrant, police entered the defendant's residence and discovered 98 bags of heroin, four digital scales and numerous glassine baggies commonly used to package heroin.

NAVARRO faces 7 years in State Prison followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on May 15, 2013.

ISIAH SAUNDERS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Court on April 9, 2013.

On January 19, 2013, SAUNDERS was a passenger in a vehicle that was pulled over for inadequate brake lights on Southern Boulevard in the City of Albany. When New York State Troopers approached the vehicle, they detected a strong odor of marijuana from inside the vehicle as well as on the defendant's person.

When officers observed SAUNDERS reach into his waistband, Troopers removed the defendant from the vehicle and began a search, finding a digital scale in the defendant's pocket. Upon a further search of the defendant, approximately 13 grams of cocaine were recovered.

SAUNDERS faces 6 years in State Prison followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on May 14, 2013.

DAYSHON MILLER was sentenced to 3 years in State Prison followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Court on April 3, 2013.

On February 21, 2013, MILLER pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony.

On August 21 and August 23, 2012, MILLER was observed by members of the Albany Police Department selling crack cocaine in area of Second Street in the City of Albany.

LEROY CHISOLM was sentenced to 6 years in State Prison followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court on April 2, 2013.

On February 8, 2013, CHISOLM pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony.

On October 30, 2012 CHISOLM was observed by members of the Albany Police Department selling 11 bags of heroin in the area of the Ida Yarborough Apartments in the City of Albany. On November 6, 2012, the defendant was observed selling 40 bags of heroin in the area of the Ida Yarborough Apartments.

Pursuant to a search warrant, police entered the defendant's residence where they recovered 25 additional bags of heroin, a digital scale, a quantity of marijuana and approximately \$800 in cash.

Assistant District Attorney Jasper Mills of the Street Crimes Bureau is handling the prosecution of these cases.
