Albany Man Found Guilty of Attempted Assault



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that QUASHON SURGICK, 27, of Albany, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the Third Degree, a Class B Misdemeanor, before the Honorable Joshua Farrell in Albany City Court yesterday afternoon.

After reviewing the evidence-based case, including photographs, a recorded 911 call, and officer testimony during trial, the jury concluded that on January 28, 2018, while at a residence on Lincoln Square in the City of Albany, SURGICK did attempt to cause physical injury to a person

who was known to him after an argument that occurred inside of the residence. Due to the altercation, the victim sustained bruising and pain to her right eye and was later treated.

SURGICK faces up to 3 months in Albany County Jail when sentenced on November 29, 2018.

Assistant District Attorney Bryanne Perlanski is handling the prosecution of this case.
