Albany Teen Pleads Guilty To Attempted Burglary, Faces Up To 4 Years In State Prison



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that RAHMIEL GAMBLE, 19, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, before Judge Joseph Teresi in Albany Supreme Court this morning.

On August 20, 2012 at 11:30pm, GAMBLE unlawfully entered a residence on Lark Street in the City of Albany by kicking in the basement door. Once inside, GAMBLE began to bag up an X-Box game system when a tenant who lived in the building confronted GAMBLE and was able to contact the Albany Police Department.

GAMBLE faces up to 4 years in State Prison, followed by 3 years of post-release supervision when he is sentenced on November 20, 2012.

Assistant District Attorney Benjamin Mastaitis of the Major Offenses Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
