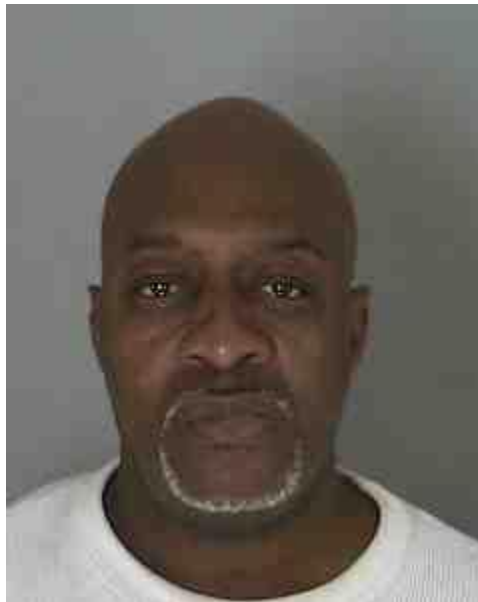

Burglar Pleads Guilty After Domestic Break-In



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ROBERT JONES, 51, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On February 22, 2014, at a residence on Sherman Street in the City of Albany, JONES did unlawfully enter the residence of a victim who was known to him. While unlawfully inside the residence, JONES did threaten the victim, as well as a four year old child and another witness

that was in the home. JONES then struck the victim, knocking her unconscious before fleeing the residence.

JONES faces 5 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, when sentenced on November 17, 2014.

Assistant District Attorney Jennifer McCanney of the Special Victims Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
