Burglar Rides Away on Bike with Flat Screen TV



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that NAZIR ROSS, 16, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony, this morning in Albany County Court before Judge Stephen W. Herrick.

On December 28, 2012 at approximately 9:30 in the morning, ROSS did illegally enter a residence on Parkwood Street in the City of Albany and steal a television, a video game console, and various video games and controllers. Video surveillance from a local school showed ROSS parking his bicycle in front of the residence. After ROSS left the residence with the items, he was observed by a passerby as he was riding his bicycle on a nearby street. The passerby took out her phone and was able to take photos of ROSS carrying the television while riding the bike. Aware that someone was taking his photo, ROSS then discarded the items in the bushes and rode away. The items were later recovered by police and identified by the homeowner on Parkwood Street.

ROSS faces (5) years in State Prison, to be followed by (3) years of Post-Release Supervision, when sentenced on May 7, 2013.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp handled the prosecution of this case.
