Drug Charges for Two Men in Alleged Heroin Possession and Sale



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that PEDRO ROBLES, 37, of Watervliet, was arraigned on (2) Counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, both Class B Felonies, before the Honorable Judge Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On May 18, 2015, at approximately 5 p.m., at 2100 Second Avenue City of Watervliet, PEDRO ROBLES allegedly sold heroin to another person for a sum of United States Currency. The action was allegedly repeated on May 26, 2015, at approximately 6 p.m., at 100 Troy-

Schenectady Road, in the City of Watervliet.

No bail was set for PEDRO ROBLES. He is due back in Albany County Court for an appearance on June 11, 2015.

RAYMOND ROBLES, 22, of Watervliet, the nephew of PEDRO ROBLES, had bail set at \$25,000 cash or bond for drug possession charges in Albany County Court this morning before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch.

On June 1, 2015, at approximately 4:45 p.m., on Lower Hudson Avenue in the Town of Green Island, City of Watervliet, RAYMOND ROBLES allegedly possessed approximately 60 glassine envelopes, each containing heroin. The drugs were allegedly possessed with the intent to sell.

Assistant District Attorney Joseph Brucato of the Street Crimes Unit is prosecuting these cases.
