Fingerprint Left at Scene Lands Defendant in State Prison



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **KADEEM STEWART**, 17, of Albany, was sentenced to 4 ½ years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post-Release Supervision, before Honorable Stephen W. Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On June 24, 2014, **STEWART** pleaded guilty to an indictment charging (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C Violent Felony.

On January 14, 2014, at 2:50am, STEWART did illegally enter a residence on Park Avenue in the City of Albany by breaking in a rear window. While inside STEWART did steal a laptop computer and a sum of US currency. The owner woke up and saw STEWART running away from the residence. An analysis of fingerprints left on the window revealed a positive match to STEWART. Police officers later found STEWART to be in possession of the stolen laptop.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp prosecuted this case.
