Guilty Plea for Man Who Crashed Stolen Car While Driving Drunk with Illegal Weapon in Vehicle



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JAHMEL INMAN, 23, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class D Armed Felony, and (1) Count of Driving While Ability Impaired, a Violation, before the Honorable Judge Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On September 3, 2016, at approximately 8:09 p.m., INMAN was operating a 2005 Jeep in an impaired condition and crashed in to another motor vehicle while near First Street and Henry Johnson Boulevard in the City of Albany. Members of the Albany Police Department responded to the crash and found a loaded .40 caliber handgun in the center console of the vehicle that INMAN was driving. Further investigation uncovered that the vehicle had been stolen by INMAN earlier that day.

INMAN faces 5 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, when sentenced on December 15, 2016.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Street Crimes Unit is prosecuting this case.
