## Guilty Plea for Repeat Albany Burglaries



**ALBANY, NY** - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **ANDREW GONZALEZ**, 26, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C Violent Felony, before the Honorable Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Court this morning.

On separate dates in July 2014, **GONZALEZ** did unlawfully enter three residences in the City of

Albany on Yates Street, Morris Street, and Myrtle Avenue. While inside these residences, GONZALEZ did steal multiple items of property, including electronics, computers, jewelry, video game systems, and a camera. A search warrant of GONZALEZ's residence did uncover some of the stolen items. The guilty plea today satisfies all of the burglary charges that GONZALEZ was facing from these incidents.

GONZALEZ faces 13 years in State Prison when sentenced on May 22, 2015. GONZALEZ will also be ordered to pay restitution to the victims for the items that were not recovered.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hauf of the Major Crimes Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
