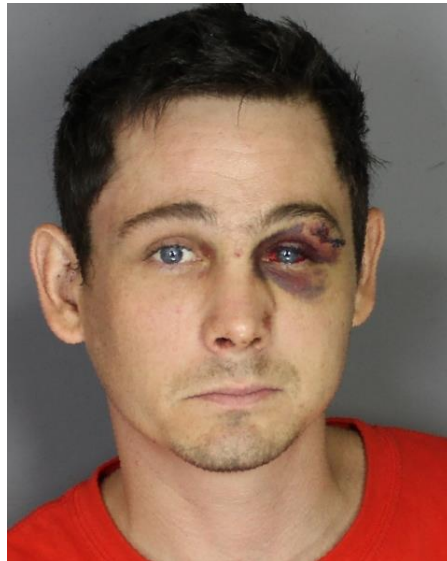

Guilty Plea in Aggravated Vehicular Assault



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that AARON BOOMHOWER, 29, of Schenectady, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Aggravated Vehicular Assault, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court.

On June 17, 2017, at around 9:45 AM, in the area of Colehill Road, in the Town of Berne, BOOMHOWER did lose control of his vehicle, went off the road, and struck a tree. The two passengers in his vehicle were ejected, with the female passenger sustaining serious physical injuries. BOOMHOWER did refuse a chemical test and a court order was obtained to draw his

blood. The results revealed BOOMHOWER did have a blood alcohol content level of .15 while operating the vehicle.

BOOMHOWER faces 2 1/3 to 7 years in State Prison when sentenced on December 6, 2017.

Assistant District Attorney Michael Shanley of the Vehicular Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
