Guilty Plea in Albany Shooting Case



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that KEVIN DOUGLAS, 22, of Brooklyn, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class C Armed Violent Felony, before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court this afternoon.

On November 24, 2016, at approximately 12:45 P.M., DOUGLAS unlawfully entered a residence on Clinton Avenue in the City of Albany and fired a loaded firearm at a male victim that was known to him, striking him in the back. DOUGLAS then fled the scene. Video surveillance captured DOUGLAS leaving the scene with the firearm still in his hand. Members of the Albany Police Department responded to the scene and DOUGLAS was apprehended later that day. DOUGLAS confessed to shooting the victim. The victim survived the attack and was treated for injuries at an area hospital.

DOUGLAS faces 12 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision, when sentenced on June 27, 2017.

Assistant District Attorney Dennis DiBari of the Major Offense Unit prosecuted this case.
