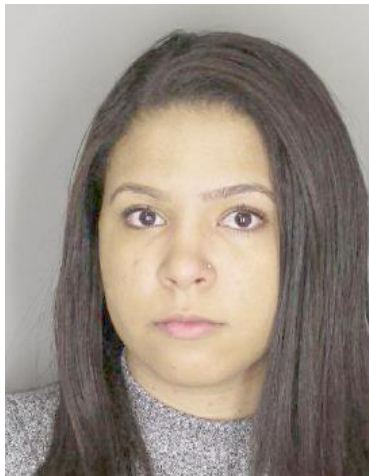

Guilty Plea in Bus Case

ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **ALEXIS BRIGGS**, 21, of Elmira Heights, NY, pleaded guilty for her role in an incident that occurred on January 30, 2016 aboard a CDTA bus.

BRIGGS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Disorderly Conduct, a Violation, and faces a conditional discharge after the completion of 100 hours of community service.

In open court today **BRIGGS** read a statement apologizing for her actions during the incident.

“Today Ms. Briggs took responsibility for her conduct and publically recognized the impact that her actions have left on our community,” commented DA Soares. “Her apology to the University community and to the students affected by this incident will enable her to move forward to the bright future that lies ahead of her.”

Charges remain open and pending for two other co-defendants who were previously indicted for their respective roles during the incident and in the days following.

Chief Assistant District Attorney David Rossi is handling the prosecution of this case.
