## Guilty Plea in Death of Five Week Old Infant

**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that CAVADEAS TAYLOR, 19, of Kingston, New York, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Manslaughter in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, a Class B Felony, before the Honorable Roger McDonough in the Supreme Court of Albany County this morning for his role in causing the death of a five week old infant.

The cases remains open and pending against co-defendant SETH KNOX SR., 26, also of Kingston, who has been charged with (1) Count of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, a Class A Misdemeanor.

A previously filed indictment alleges that between June 11 and June 12, 2013 at a residence on Second Street in the City of Albany, CAVADEAS TAYLOR did recklessly engage in conduct which created a grave risk of death that ultimately resulted in the death of infant Seth Knox, Jr.

Additionally, the indictment alleges that SETH KNOX SR allegedly failed to seek prompt and adequate medical attention for his son who was having difficulty breathing.

TAYLOR remains in custody and faces 15 years in State Prison, to be followed by 15 years of Post-Release Supervision when sentenced on July 25, 2014.

Special Victims Unit Bureau Chief Shannon Sarfoh is handling the prosecution of these cases.
