Guilty Plea in March 2018 Homicide



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JODI NOISSEAU, 48, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Manslaughter in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning in relation to the March homicide of 24 year old Keisha Richards.

On the 14th and 15th days of March, 2018, NOISSEAU, personally or while acting in concert with others, recklessly caused the death of Keisha Richards when, knowing that she was experiencing an overdose due to toxic consumption, they transported her from Columbia

Turnpike in the City of Rensselaer to a residence on Partridge Street in the City of Albany, where she was left for approximately twelve hours without medical attention and then discarded in a snowbank whereupon she was discovered and subsequently pronounced dead.

NOISSEAU faces up to 5 to 15 years in State Prison when sentenced at a later date.

The cases against alleged co-defendants CHRISTOPHER KONDRACKI and TAMALE HARRIS are open and pending. On separate dates, KONDRACKI and HARRIS were arraigned and both pleaded not guilty to the charges.

The Court has not scheduled return appearance dates for the above charged parties at this time.

Street Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Jessica Blain-Lewis and Assistant District Attorney Megan Spillane are handling the prosecution of this case.
