Guilty Plea in Residential Robbery Case



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **CARLOS LOPEZ-RODRIGUEZ**, 50, of Coeymans, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Burglary in the 2nd Degree, a Class D Felony, before the Honorable Judge Thomas A. Breslin in Albany Supreme Court yesterday.

On two separate occasions in April 2016, **LOPEZ-RODRIGUEZ** unlawfully entered his neighbor's home in the Town of Coeymans, taking various collectibles and property totaling an

amount of approximately \$15,000. After being arrested by the Coeymans Police Department, LOPEZ-RODRIGUEZ admitted that he committed the burglaries.

LOPEZ-RODRIGUEZ faces up to 5 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision, as well as being ordered to pay \$15,000 in restitution to the victim, when sentenced on December 12, 2016.

Assistant District Attorney Joseph Brucato of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
