Guilty Plea in September 2018 Homicide Case



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DAYTWAN PERKINS, 38, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Manslaughter in the First Degree, a Class B Violent Felony, before the Honorable Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this afternoon for his role in a September 2018 homicide that took place on North Swan Street in the City of Albany.

Today in Court, PERKINS admitted that on the 11th day of September, 2018, at approximately 12:08 a.m., PERKINS, with the intent to cause serious physical injury to the victim, caused the death of Barry Tyce, Jr. inside of 55 ½ North Swan Street in the City of Albany by means of shooting him with a loaded pistol.

PERKINS faces up to 20 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post- Release Supervision, when sentenced on May 24, 2019.

Street Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Jessica Blain-Lewis and Assistant District Attorney Megan Spillane are handling the prosecution of this case.
