Guilty Plea in Watervliet Home Burglary



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares today announced that THOMAS MATUSIE, 17, of Watervliet, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony, this morning in Albany County Court before Honorable Thomas A. Breslin.

On July 27, 2012 MATUSIE burglarized a residence in the City of Watervliet while the residents were away on vacation and stole jewelry, coins, and prescription medication from the home.

In addition to restitution for the jewelry items that were not recovered, MATUSIE faces up to 4 years in State Prison to be followed by 3 years of post-release supervision when sentenced on November 30, 2012.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hauf of the Major Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
