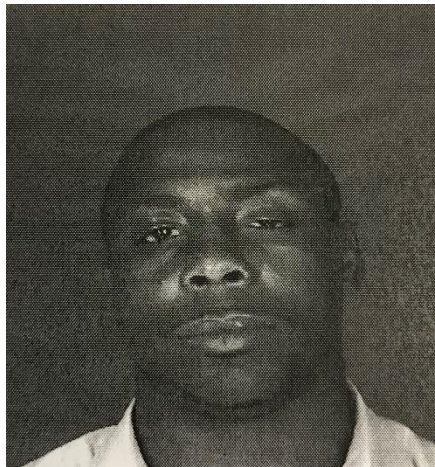

## **Guilty Verdict after Felony DWI Trial**



**ALBANY, NY** – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that QUINE LIDDELL, 37, of Albany, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a Class E Felony, before visiting Judge Richard McNally in Albany County Court this afternoon.

On October 30, 2016, at approximately 10:15 P.M., an officer from the New York State Police Department conducted a traffic stop near the Exit 25 Toll Plaza on the New York State Thruway after an expired inspection sticker was observed on a passing vehicle being driven by LIDDELL. The Trooper detected the smell of alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle during the traffic stop. LIDDELL failed two out of three standardized field sobriety tests and was taken in to

custody. LIDDELL submitted to a chemical breath test and registered a .09 per cent blood alcohol concentration approximately 30 minutes after the stop.

LIDDELL has two previous convictions for alcohol related driving incidents.

LIDDELL faces up to 4 years in State Prison when he is sentenced on June 13, 2018.

Assistant District Attorney Garrett Barmore handled the prosecution of this case.
