Guilty Verdict After Heroin and Cocaine Sale Jury Trial



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that EDMOND WILLIAMS, 47, of Troy, was found guilty after a jury trial of (2) Counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, each Class B Felonies, (2) Counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, each Class B Felonies, and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court yesterday.

A jury found that on September 28, 2015, at approximately 8:00 P.M., between Phillip Street and Park Avenue in the City of Albany, an ongoing investigation by the Albany Police Department uncovered WILLIAMS attempting to sell 100 bags of heroin and 10 grams of crack cocaine.

WILLIAMS faces up to 12 years in State Prison when sentenced on May 16, 2017.

Assistant District Attorney Megan Spillane of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
