Guilty Verdict after Albany Slashing Trial



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares today announced that ALEX PEREZ, 42, of Albany, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the First Degree, a Class C Violent Felony, and (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Court this afternoon.

The jury found that on November 27, 2017, at approximately 8:30 PM, in the area of Second Street in the City of Albany, PEREZ attempted to cause serious physical injury to the victim by using a dangerous instrument. Specifically, PEREZ ambushed the victim with a razor blade,

sliced his ear, and also stabbed the victim in the back. The victim was treated for his injuries and survived.

PEREZ faces up to 15 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post- Release Supervision, when sentenced on April 24, 2019.

Assistant District Attorneys Joseph Brucato and David Szalda are handling the prosecution of this case.
