## Guilty Verdict after Stabbing Trial



**ALBANY, NY** – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that COREEN HARRIS, 35, of Schenectady, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Assault in the First Degree, a Class B Violent Felony, (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Court this afternoon.

On January 17, 2016, at approximately 9:00 P.M., while inside a residence on Consaul Road in the Town of Colonie, HARRIS did stab an adult male that was known to him with a knife. This assault caused serious physical injury and protracted disfigurement from stab wounds to the face and nose, in addition to physical injury by a stab wound to the chest. The victim sustained injury wounds that required surgery to repair. After the incident HARRIS fled the area and was later apprehended in Queens.

Assistant District Attorney Brittany Grome and Assistant District Attorney Stephen Lydon prosecuted this case at trial.

HARRIS faces up to 25 years in State Prison when sentenced on July 13, 2017.
