## **Guilty Verdict in Domestic Violence Case**



**ALBANY, NY** – District Attorney P. David Soares today announced that ERIC DAVIS, 32, of Troy, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Criminal Contempt in the First Degree, a Class E Felony, and (3) Counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, all Class A Misdemeanors, before Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court today.

On June 16, 2012 at a residence in the City of Albany, DAVIS did violate a No Contact Order of Protection by physically assaulting and strangling a former intimate partner in the presence of her three children. DAVIS had previously been instructed by the court to have no contact with this person.

DAVIS faces up to 3 years in State Prison when sentenced on March 26, 2013.

Assistant District Attorney Carmen Warner of the Special Victims Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
