## **Illegal Possession of Loaded Firearm Leads to 10 Year Prison Sentence**



**ALBANY, NY** – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **KALIM LEWIS**, 21, of Albany, was sentenced to 10 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court this morning.

On August 31, 2018, **LEWIS** was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class C Armed Violent Felony.

The jury found that on November 9, 2017, in the area of Kent Street in the City of Albany, LEWIS illegally possessed a loaded firearm. A search warrant executed at LEWIS' residence by the New York State Police recovered a loaded handgun in LEWIS' bedroom, next to where he was sleeping.

Assistant District Attorney Megan Spillane of the Street Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
