Jurors Return Guilty Verdict in Shooting Case



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **ANDRE MCCAULEY**, 30, of Guilderland, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the First Degree, a Class C Violent Felony, before the Honorable Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Court yesterday afternoon.

On Friday June 27, 2014 at approximately 3:00 p.m., in the area of 187 Bradford Street in the City of Albany, **MCCAULEY** did intentionally shoot at a 26 year old adult male that was known to him with the intent to cause serious physical injury. Members of the Albany Police Department arrived at the scene and located a victim of a grazed gunshot wound. The victim was treated and survived the encounter.

MCCAULEY faces up to 15 years in State Prison when sentenced on June 5, 2015.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
