Justice Carl Landicino Pleads Guilty To Driving While Intoxicated



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced that CARL LANDICINO, 47, of Yorktown Heights, NY, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, an unclassified Misdemeanor, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On October 17, 2012, LANDICINO was observed by State Police driving erratically, making unsafe lane changes and speeding on I-87. After State Police pulled LANDICINO over, LANDICINO showed physical signs of intoxication. LANDICINO told the trooper he was on his way back from a judicial conference.

LANDICINO serves as a State Supreme Court Justice from Westchester County, NY.

In addition to pleading guilty, LANDICINO was sentenced to a 1 year Conditional Discharge requiring him to successfully complete substance abuse treatment, pay a \$500 fine, have an ignition interlock device installed on his vehicle, attend a Victim Impact Panel and Drinking Driver Program, and have his license suspended for a period of six months.

Vehicular Crimes Bureau Chief Mary Tanner-Richter prosecuted this case.
