## Man Admits Green Island Burglaries



**ALBANY, NY** – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DANNY WHITE, 22, of Troy, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C violent felony before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On March 4, 2016, police were called to a residence on James Street in the Village of Green Island for a report of a burglary in progress, where the suspect then fled from the home when the homeowners came home. Officers from Cohoes, Watervliet and Troy Police Departments responded to assist. WHITE was located near the Hudson River and was taken into custody, where police found several of the stolen items on his person. WHITE also admitted to

committing several other burglaries in Green Island.

WHITE faces 8 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, when sentenced on July 27, 2016.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hauf of the Major Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
