Man Found Secretly Transporting Cocaine in Buttocks



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **MICHAEL WILLIAMS**, 41, of Colonie, was sentenced to 4 1/2 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On July 22, 2015, WILLIAMS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree, a Class C Felony.

Early in the morning on March 6, 2015, on Troy-Schenectady Road in Colonie, WILLIAMS was found to be in possession of a quantity of marijuana. After checking his name, Colonie Police found that WILLIAMS had an active parole warrant. He was placed into custody and, during transport back to the station, WILLIAMS discarded a bag of marijuana in the back of the police vehicle. At approximately 2:20 a.m., after being searched at the Colonie Police Station, WILLIAMS was found to have 6.8 grams of crack cocaine in his buttocks.

“Mr. Williams, in addition to putting others at risk, placed himself at risk by having these drugs in his anus,” DA Soares said. “There have been instances in the past where balloons and other receptacles in the same location have burst, causing overdoses.”

Assistant District Attorney Megan Spillane of the Street Crimes Unit is prosecuting this case.
