Man Sentenced for Crashing Vehicle into Local Business



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DANIEL FRAZIER, 44, of Albany, was sentenced to 1 ½ to 4 ½ years in State Prison before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On December 14, 2015, FRAZIER pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Reckless Endangerment in the First Degree, a Class D Felony.

On September 4, 2015, FRAZIER was driving westbound on Central Avenue in the town of Colonie. FRAZIER recklessly drove his vehicle off the roadway and crashed into a telephone pole. FRAZIER continued driving for approximately 100 yards and then crashed into a business at 2167 Central Avenue. Neither FRAZIER nor the passenger in the vehicle were physically harmed, but the building FRAZIER crashed into had to be demolished.

Assistant District Attorney David Szalda of the Vehicular Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
