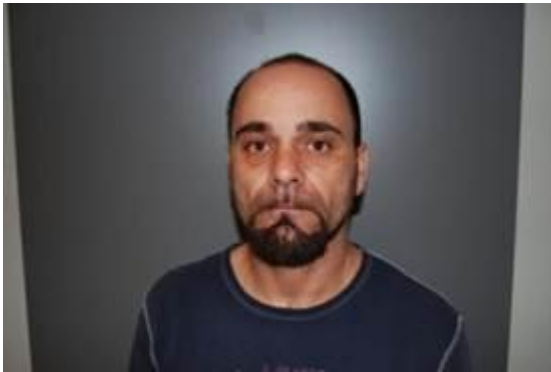

Marijuana Mailed to Man Leads to Conviction



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced that ADAM VANVORST, 40, of Albany, was convicted after a jury trial of (1) Count of Criminal Possession of Marijuana in the First Degree, a Class C Felony before the Honorable Dan Lamont last night in Albany County Court.

On December 9, 2011, VANVORST was observed receiving and signing for a delivery package using a false name. The package contained several heat sealed clear bags of marijuana, which was later determined to be 12.25 pounds in weight.

“Stopping the flow of illegal drugs in Albany County is a top priority for my office. I applaud the work of the postal service and law enforcement on this case, and will continue to support their efforts to rid our community of those who supply drugs,” commented DA Soares.

VANVORST faces 5 ½ years in State Prison when is sentenced on November 2, 2012.

Assistant District Attorney Jasper Mills of the Street Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
