Murder Indictment Unsealed in January Homicide



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that SHAKIR REDMON, 27, of Albany, was arraigned before Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning in relation to the January 2018 homicide of 35 year old Anthony Malloy.

A Grand Jury previously returned charges against REDMON, alleging that he committed (1) Count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-I Felony, (1) Count of Conspiracy in the Second Degree, a Class B Felony, (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second

Degree, a Class C Armed Violent Felony, and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, Class B Felony.

The indictment alleges that on the 4th day of January, 2018, REDMON caused the death of Anthony Malloy in the area of First and Quail Street in the City of Albany. The indictment also alleges that REDMON obtained a vehicle from another for use in carrying out the conspiracy of murder and illegally possessed a loaded firearm. Additionally, the indictment also alleges that REDMON illegally possessed a quantity of cocaine with the intent to sell it on January 4, 2018 in the area of Cortland Place in the City of Albany.

REDMON pleaded not guilty to the charges today in Court and is in custody. No new appearance dates have been scheduled by the Court. REDMON is represented by the Albany County Alternate Public Defender's Office.

Chief Assistant David Rossi and Assistant District Attorney David Szalda are handling the prosecution of this case.
