Repeat Armed Robber Pleads Guilty



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that CHRISTOPHER WYNN, 42, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Robbery in the First Degree, a Class B Violent Felony, before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court yesterday morning.

Through an extensive investigation led by the Albany Police Department, WYNN was identified as the perpetrator of (10) separate armed robberies of commercial stores located in the City of Albany between the dates of November 12, 2014 and January 25, 2015. The

guilty plea satisfies charges that on (7) of these dates, WYNN did rob the same store located on Southern Boulevard while displaying what appeared to be a handgun. During several of the incidents, WYNN threatened to shoot the store clerks if they did not comply. The guilty plea also satisfies a charge that while robbing a store on Delaware Avenue WYNN did strike the store clerk in the head with what appeared to be a handgun. WYNN did also rob stores located on South Pearl Street and Western Avenue.

WYNN faces 19 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, when sentenced on June 12, 2015.

Major Offense Bureau Chief Shannon Corbitt is prosecuting this case.
