Repeat Drunk Driver Sentenced



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that KEVIN MURRAY, 51, of Latham, was sentenced to 6 months in Albany County Jail with a consecutive 5 Years of Felony Probation before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court yesterday morning on his conviction for Driving While Intoxicated, a Class E Felony, as well as a

concurrent 6 months in Albany County Jail in his conviction of Circumvention of an Interlock Device, a Class A Misdemeanor.

On March 5, 2015 at approximately 2 p.m., on Central Avenue in the Town of Colonie, MURRAY was involved in a Property Damage Auto Accident and fled the scene. He crashed his vehicle a second time by driving into a snowbank and fled on foot. MURRAY was apprehended on Fuller Road. He had physical signs of intoxication and failed the standard field sobriety tests. MURRAY refused a chemical test at the police station.

Murray was previously convicted of Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated as a misdemeanor in 2014.

In addition to his Albany County Jail Sentence, MURRAY must also pay a \$1,000 fine, be subject to a driver's license revocation for a minimum of 1 year subject to the Department of Motor Vehicles guidelines, be subject to Ignition Interlock Restriction for his 5 Years of Probation, and attend a Victim Impact Panel.

Assistant District Attorney Mary Tanner-Richter of the Vehicular Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
