Robber Pleads Guilty to Stealing From Senior Citizen



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DANIEL DECENZO, 21, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

DECENZO did forcibly steal property and did cause physical injury to an 89 year old woman on May 19, 2014 in the area of New Scotland Avenue and Quail Street in the City of Albany, when he forcibly stole the victim's purse and threw her to ground. Bystanders were able to aid the woman and call for help.

DECENZO faces up to 7 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post-Release Supervision, when sentenced on September 9, 2014.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp is handling the prosecution of this case.
