## Sentencing After Sexual Assault of a Minor



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that KEIMAR TARVER, 33, of Albany, was sentenced to 13 years in State Prison, to be followed by 15 years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable Judge Stephen W. Herrick in Albany County Court this morning for a May 2013 sexual assault. This sentence will run consecutively to a 5 year State Prison term that TARVER is currently serving for a May 2014 drug sale conviction.

On October 10, 2014, TARVER was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Rape in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony, (1) Count of Criminal Sexual Act in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony, and (1) Count of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, a Class A Misdemeanor.

On May 5, 2013, TARVER did sexually assault a minor under the age of 17 that was known to him while at a residence on Orange Street in the City of Albany.

An investigation led by the Albany Police Department, in conjunction with DNA evidence, led to the successful prosecution of TARVER.

TARVER will also have to register as a Sex Offender.

Special Victims Unit Bureau Chief Shannon Sarfoh prosecuted this case.
