## Sentencing for Man Driving Drunk



**ALBANY, NY** - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ISAIAH JOHNSON, 34, of Albany, was sentenced to 1 to 3 years in State Prison, 3 years of mandatory Ignition Interlock Device upon release from custody, and 18 months minimum license revocation, subject to the Department of Motor Vehicles, before Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court today.

On November 13, 2014, JOHNSON pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Aggravated Driving While

Intoxicated, a Class E Felony.

On February 15, 2014, at approximately 2:28am, JOHNSON was seen driving his car without headlights on Lark Street in the City of Albany. When JOHNSON was pulled over he showed physical signs of intoxication and admitted that his license had been suspended. He was also driving without a license. JOHNSON failed the standard field sobriety tests and registered a blood alcohol content of .22% (almost 3 times the legal limit) approximately one hour after the stop.

Vehicular Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Mary Tanner-Richter is prosecuting this case.
