Sentencing for Repeat DWI Offender



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **DARNELL COLLINS**, 29, of Albany, was sentenced to 1 1/3 – 4 years in State Prison, the installation of an Ignition Interlock Device for 3 years following his release from custody, a \$3,000 fine and a minimum of 18 months of license revocation, subject to the Department of Motor Vehicles, before the Honorable Judge Andrew Ceresia in Albany County Court yesterday morning.

On June 18, 2015, **COLLINS** pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated, a Class E Felony, and (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a Class E Felony.

On November 14, 2014, COLLINS crashed his car on I-787. Upon being placed under arrest and taken into custody, COLLINS registered a BAC of .22%.

On March 1, 2015, COLLINS was found passed out behind the wheel of a running vehicle under a red light in the City of Albany. COLLINS exhibited signs of intoxication and refused to do any standard field sobriety test. Due to the prior DWI incident from November 2014, COLLINS was operating the vehicle with a suspended license.

COLLINS guilty plea in June was in full satisfaction of both DWI Charges.

Assistant District Attorney Melinda Seiden-Fiorino of the Vehicular Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
