Sentencing for Repeated Violations of Order of Protection



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **VICTOR WILLIAMS**, 49, of Albany, was sentenced to 3 ½ to 7 years in State Prison, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

WILLIAMS was also sentenced to 1 ½ to 3 years in State Prison for the (1) Count of Criminal Contempt in the First Degree, to run concurrent to the 3 ½ to 7 years sentence.

On December 15, 2014, WILLIAMS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Aggravated Criminal Contempt, a Class D Felony, and (1) Count of Criminal Contempt in the First Degree, a Class E Felony.

Between July 9, 2014, and July 24, 2014 at multiple locations in the City of Albany, WILLIAMS did violate a duly served Order of Protection numerous times by contacting and threatening the protected party. WILLIAMS placed multiple phone calls in which he threatened the victim with physical harm. WILLIAMS also threatened the victim with a brick and then shattered both her front car windshield and passenger side window.

Assistant District Attorney Jennifer McCanney of the Special Victims Unit prosecuted this case.
