Sentencing for Using Counterfeit Bills



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **JASON PIGLIAVENTO**, 34, of Schenectady, was sentenced to 2 to 6 years in State Prison before the Honorable Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court last Friday.

On November 12, 2015, PIGLIAVENTO pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony.

On December 28, 2014 and December 29, 2014, PIGLIAVENTO did unlawfully possess three counterfeit fifty dollar bills and nineteen counterfeit twenty dollar bills, and did use them at two restaurants in the Town of Colonie.

PIGLIAVENTO will also be required to pay a total of \$530.00 in restitution to the restaurants where he did knowingly and unlawfully use counterfeit bills.

Financial Crimes Bureau Chief Daniel Lynch handled the prosecution of this case.
