Sentencing in Broad Street Homicide



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that NEVIN ROBERTS, 30, of Albany, was sentenced to 20 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On July 17, 2016, ROBERTS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Manslaughter in the First Degree, a Class B Felony.

On July 11, 2015, at approximately 10:30 p.m., in the area of 67 Broad Street, ROBERTS did have an altercation with another in the vestibule of the building. During the course of the altercation, ROBERTS stabbed the man, later identified as 29 year old Timothy Sprigs, resulting in his death.

Special Victims Unit Bureau Chief Shannon Sarfoh prosecuted this case.
